FOREIGN LANGUAGE TEACHING ASSISTANT (FLTA) FELLOWSHIPS

Five grants are offered to Israeli citizens whose mother tongue is Arabic and who are teachers or have teaching experience, in support of participation in a 2019/2020 academic year program. Fellows will teach Arabic at a U.S. academic institution (up to 20 hours a week) and, in parallel, will take courses at that institution in US studies and other subjects as they prefer (at least two courses per semester) and facilitate cultural events, language clubs, and language tables.

Program Description:

The Fulbright FLTA Program is a non-degree program for early career English teachers and other professionals. Participants have the opportunity to refine their teaching skills, increase their English language proficiency, and extend their knowledge of the society and culture of the United States while serving as teaching assistants for their native language to U.S. students.

Eligibility:

Candidates must obtain an academic degree by June 1, 2019, have experience in teaching, and not be U.S. citizens or dual U.S.-Israeli citizens.
