



Scholarship to Study in Germany – call for applications

The International Relations Unit invites all 2nd, 3rd, and 4th year students at Sakhnin College to apply for a scholarship to participate in a semester studying "Social work and Exclusion" in Germany at the Catholic University of Applied Sciences (Katho). [READ ABOUT THE PROGRAM HERE.](#)

The study program is from **25 March to 19 July, 2024.**

With an Erasmus+ mobility grant provided by the European Commission, we are able to offer scholarships for two students, who will each receive the amount of **€4,355 Euros** (approx. ₪17,500) to cover the cost of tuition, travel, accommodations, visas, and health insurance for the entire semester.

Please note that students must have an adequate level of English.

The application process is that you first apply to Sakhnin College by 05 October, who will nominate two students to Katho by 10 October. Thereafter, the nominated students will coordinate with Katho to finalize the applications and be confirmed participants of the program.

The scholarship selection committee is Prof. Yaser Awad, Vice President of Research and Strategic Planning, and Ms. Jennifer Sheffield, International Relations Manager.
